



Student Shadow Day

Often the best way for a student to envision themselves at Providence is to experience it first-hand by shadowing for a day. Students may choose to shadow at any point during the school year. The Admissions Director will work with you to choose a day that works best for you and allows the student to experience as much as possible.

Grammar School

Typically, students spend half of the day in their current grade and half of their day in the grade they will be going into. This gives students the opportunity to meet their classmates who will move up with them the next year and it allows them to compare their current classes to the ones at Providence. Seeing the grade they will go into allows them to potentially meet the teacher they will have and get a feel for the classes they will be able to experience.

Student Drop-off

Grammar students should be checked in at the Main Office by a parent at 7:45 a.m. The Admissions Director will meet them there and introduce them to their first teacher. Parents may park in the open parking spaces in front of the building or in the large parking lot west of the building. Please do not park next to the curb in front of the school as this will block the normal flow of traffic during drop-off.

Student Pick-up

Parents need to sign their student out in the Main Office at 3:15 p.m. You may park in the large parking lot to the west of the building but please do not park in the spaces in front of the building for pick-up - the traffic is heavier after school and it is unsafe to walk between cars at this time.

What to Bring

Students should bring a spiral notebook, a pencil, outdoor clothes appropriate for recess, and pack a cold lunch and a snack. Students should dress in casual clothes and wear tennis shoes. Providence students in 6th grade change clothes for Phy-Ed, but this is not expected for students shadowing.

Logic & Rhetoric School

Students will experience a combination of classes both in their current grade and for the grade they are going into. The Admissions Director will have you complete a class list that

will aid in creating a schedule for the day that allows the student to see classes and electives that will be meaningful for them.

Student Drop off

L&R students should be checked in at the Main Office by a parent at 7:20 a.m. The Admissions Director will meet them there and introduce them to the L&R principal and be paired with a Providence student for the day. Parents may park in the open parking spaces in front of the building or in the large parking lot west of the building. Please do not park next to the curb in front of the school as this will block the normal flow of traffic during drop-off.

Student Pick-up

Parents need to sign their student out in the Main Office at 3:10 p.m. You may park in the large parking lot to the west of the building but please do not park in the spaces in front of the building for pick-up - the traffic is heavier after school and it is unsafe to walk between cars at this time.

What to Bring

Students should bring a spiral notebook, a pencil, outdoor clothes appropriate for recess (students through 12th grade are expected to go outside for recess after lunch), and pack a cold lunch and a snack. Students should dress in casual clothes and wear tennis shoes. Starting in 6th grade, Providence students change clothes for Phy-Ed, but this is not expected for students shadowing.
